


What are we learning this half term in Class 2?

In English we are:

- Reading and exploring the text 'Lady Daisy'.
- Investigating modern and Victorian language.
- Exploring the structure of a diary entry.
- Understanding how adverbials can be used in a sentence including fronted adverbials.
- Exploring the use of apostrophes for contraction.
- Understanding how prefixes can be used to change a word.
- Investigating more homophones.
- Improving our writing focusing on sentence openers and paragraphs.



In Maths we are:

- Developing mental maths strategies through our '15 minute maths' sessions.
- Recalling multiplication tables up to 10×10 .
- Exploring written methods for multiplication and division.
- Developing our mental methods of multiplication and division.
- Converting between analogue and digital time using the correct vocabulary.
- Solving problems associated with time.
- Recognising and using tenths and hundredths as unit, non-unit and decimal fractions of numbers.



Science:

This half term we are learning about 'States of matter'.



RE:

This half term we are learning about Worship & Ritual in the Jewish religion.



PE:

This half term we are developing our skills in cross country and gymnastics.



Computing:

This term our topic is 'We are co-authors'.
