Dear Parents

As the debate continues on when schools should be re-opening, I am writing to let you know of some of the actions and procedures we are putting in place at Rosley in preparation for returning to school. These will be reviewed on a regular basis and subject to change.

We are preparing for some children to return on **Monday 8th June**. The school will open for families who have both parents in key worker roles on **Monday 1st June. Please ensure you have contacted me, in this case.** In both cases, school will be open from 8.45am - 3.30pm. We will not be opening on Fridays as this day will be used for a deeper clean and teacher planning for both groups of children - those in school and those continuing with home-schooling. These procedures are in-line with Local Authority guidance. Please ensure you have emailed me regarding your child's return to school.

I am currently working with staff on the re-organisation of classrooms and pupil groupings. This is still to be finalised as some parents are still not being given their own return to work date; we need to keep plans open and flexible for the time being but I will try and let you know details of this by the end of this week.

We will endeavour to help children understand about social distancing and teachers will spend time talking to children about this. I must stress however, as recognised by the government, we cannot guarantee that children will always be able to maintain their 2m distance during the course of the day in more active sessions and continuous provision. We will not exceed 15 children in any classroom, in-line with government guidance. The school day and curriculum will be slightly different. I will write with further details of what this will look like once we have established pupil groupings.

It has come to my attention that some children are playing within the schools grounds and using the play equipment. I urge parents not to allow their children to do this during these times. We are advised that on returning to school, that use of equipment is to be minimised. Therefore, children should not be using the equipment at this time.
