

## English

In Reading and Writing Composition we are:

This term we are introducing the Read, Write, Inc programme, which will gradually feed into our English teaching. Until this is fully integrated we will:

- Study Julia Donaldson's The Smartest Giant in Town making inferences and predictions about the characters in the story
- Plan a narrative inspired by The Smartest Giant in Town
- Write a narrative inspired by the Smartest Giant in Town
- Practise correct letter formation and handwriting for lower and upper case letters

In Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling we are:

- Revising the use of capital letters and full stops at the start and end of a sentence
- Exploring the use of question marks
- Learning to use of exclamation sentences
- Using basic conjunctions to extend a sentence

In addition to this the children will work in small phonics groups.

## Science

Animals including humans

In science we will be discovering that animals and humans change throughout their lives. We will be finding out about the offspring of a range of animals such as frogs and butterflies.

We will also investigate what animals and humans need to survive and stay healthy.

## Maths

In Number we are:

Year 1

- Ordering numbers
- Counting objects
- Adding 1 more
- Counting backwards within 10
- Finding 1 less

- Creating addition and subtraction fact families

Year 2

- Writing numbers to 100 in words
- Recognising tens and ones
- Partitioning numbers to 100
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Counting in 3s
- Learning bonds to 10
- Learning addition and subtraction bonds within 20
- Finding bonds to 100
- Finding 10 more and 10 less
- Adding three 1 digit numbers
- Adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers

## PE

We are looking forward to visiting Morton Gymnastics club every week this half term.

The children will get the opportunity to develop their floor work skills. They will also be able to try out some of the equipment.

On Fridays the children will be focussing on developing fundamental movements. The children will learn how to travel with control and speed and develop their throwing and catching techniques.

## History

This term we will find out about toys from the past and present. We will look at toys from our living memory, discuss what our parents and grandparents' toys were like and discover what toys were like beyond living memory.

If you have any old toys at home it would be fantastic if you could show these to your children!

## RE

This half term we will discuss the concept of religion, what it means to hold religious beliefs and how it is important to respect the beliefs and views of others. We will then focus on how Christians show they are thankful at Harvest.

## Music

We will be exploring simple musical patterns and how by adding pitch and rhythm you can produce a range of musical effects. We will create music using our voices, body percussion and a selection of musical instruments.

## Art

The children will develop their skills this half term so they are able to design a piece of art in the same style as Paul Klee's Castle and Sun.

They will start by exploring how to draw repeating patterns and different lines. Then they will experiment to find different ways to use a paintbrush to create texture. Finally they will use these skills to create their own piece of art in the style of Paul Klee.

## Computing

This half term we will consider the many forms of technology around us and then focus on computing systems and networks, developing our skills to safely and effectively explore different forms of digital technology in the classroom.
