At Rosley CE Primary School, we use the Kapow scheme of work to assist teacher planning. Below is an overview of the learning focus for each half term in each class. Pupils receive 1 hour per week of timetabled DT lessons. These are usually taught in sequenced weekly lessons, though may be taught as a block depending on the focus and resources involved.

Class teachers may choose to adapt the learning focus to suit their class but must ensure full coverage throughout the two-yearly cycle.
