At Rosley CE Primary School, we use Read, Write Inc in EYFS and KS1 and Talk for Writing and Read, Write Inc in KS2 to assist teacher planning. Below is an overview of the learning focus for each half term in each class. Pupils receive at least 5 hours per week of timetabled English lessons. These are taught in sequenced weekly lessons. Class teachers may choose to adapt the learning focus to suit their class but must ensure full coverage throughout the two-yearly cycle.
