## GEOGRAPHY LONG TERM PLAN 2022 - 2023



At Rosley CE Primary School, we use CUSP resources to assist teacher planning. Below is an overview of the learning focus for each half term in each class. Pupils receive 1 hour per week of timetabled geography lessons every other half term. The lessons are taught weekly and cover core geographical knowledge alongside the skills stipulated on the National Curriculum.

Class teachers may choose to adapt the learning focus to suit their class but must ensure full coverage throughout the two-yearly cycle.
