At Rosley CE Primary School, we use CUSP resources to assist teacher planning. Below is an overview of the learning focus for each half term in each class. Pupils receive 2 hours per week of timetabled History lessons during the half term that History is taught (every other half term). History lessons are taught weekly in sequenced lessons that follow the school's long-term plan. Class teachers may choose to adapt the learning focus to suit their class but must ensure full coverage throughout the two-yearly cycle.
