The children will study a range of books during these lessons. They will have the opportunity to:

- Learn new phonemes and graphemes
- Make inferences and predictions about the books
- Write short stories about the books they are reading
- Learn Year 2 spelling rules

In Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling we are continuing to:

- Revise the use of capital letters and full stops at the start and end of a sentence
- Focus on letter formation and handwriting
- Use commas in lists
- Use a range of conjunctions
- Use question marks correctly

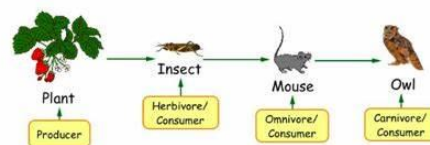
Science

Animals including humans

In science we will be continuing to learn about living things and their habitats.

We will be finding out what all living things have in common, where plants and animals live, what lives in our local area and how food chains work.

Maths

The children will cover the following objectives:

Year 1

Number: Place Value

- Can identify 1 more and 1 less
- Can identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least
- Can count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals; count in multiples of twos, fives and tens

Measurement

- Can compare, describe and solve practical problems for:
 - lengths and heights
 - mass/weight

Year 2

Measurement

- Can choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels
- Can compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity and record the results using $>$, $<$ and $=$

Statistics

- Can interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables
- Can ask and answer questions about data

PE

We are going swimming each week this term at Wigton Baths. This will be an exciting opportunity for the children to develop their water confidence and swimming technique.

We are working on our fundamental movement skills, controlling our own movements and developing our skills when controlling balls, including rolling, throwing, catching and kicking.

GEOGRAPHY

This term we will be carrying out a local geography study. We will be focussing on Rosley Village and combining this with developing basic map skills. The children will learn how to read a basic map and how to create their own map.



RE

We will be learning about Christianity with a continued focus on Holy Week and why Easter matters to Christians. We will also look at some of the ways in which Christians celebrate Easter.



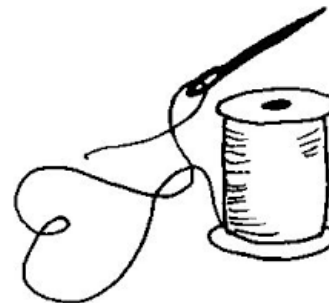
PSHE
