We will take part in a variety of gross and fine motor activities across the week.

Swimming - the children will develop their water confidence and their swimming technique.

We are working on our fundamental movement skills, controlling our own movements and developing our skills when controlling balls, including rolling, throwing, catching and kicking.

Using tools - we will use a wide range of equipment in all areas of the continuous provision.

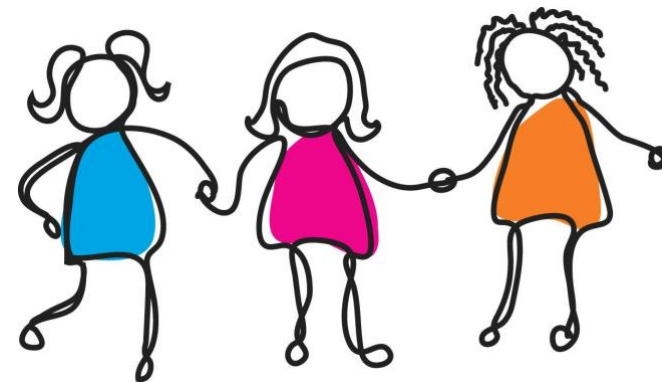
Personal, Social and Emotional development

The children will continue to focus on managing personal hygiene and dressing with increased speed and independence. They will continue to develop their interpersonal skills, as they play and talk with each other and with the adults in school.

Children will have the opportunity to explore their local community and their place within it.

This half term the children will continue to:

- Develop their ability to share and take turns
- Find a compromise
- Follow our class rules
- Focus on self-care and getting changed for swimming
- Discuss friendships and how to be a good friend



Mathematics

In maths lessons this term the children will have the opportunity to practise these skills in a variety of contexts.

They will be covering these topics:

- Counting to 9 & 10
- Comparing numbers to 10
- Bonds to 10
- 3-D shapes
- Spatial awareness
- Patterns



Understanding the world

We will be learning about Christianity with a continued focus on Holy Week and why Easter matters to Christians. We will also look at some of the ways in which Christians celebrate Easter.

We will also be learning all about where we live. We will focus on Rosley and the surrounding area.

Expressive arts and design

Music - The children will be developing their singing skills. They will use their voices, body percussion and instruments as they explore pulse, rhythm and pitch.

Art and Craft – the children will use a range of resources with greater accuracy to create work linked to our topic – Where we live.
Small World & Role Play - we will continue to develop collaborative play in these areas.

Literacy

This term we are continuing with the Read, Write, Inc phonics programme.

We are consolidating our existing phonics knowledge and learning new sounds that we will blend to form words. We will practise writing individual letters, our names, words and captions.

Children will work in Red, Write, Inc groups and access books and activities at an appropriate level.

We will enjoy sharing storybooks, focusing on extending our vocabulary, describing characters, retelling stories and predicting plots. We will also read information books, joining in with singing rhymes and songs.
