In reading and writing composition we will continue to teach English through the Read, Write, Inc programme.

The children will study a range of books during these lessons. They will have the opportunity to:

- Learn new phonemes and graphemes
- Make inferences and predictions about the books
- Write short stories about the books they are reading
- Learn Year 1 Common Exception words
- Learn Year 2 spelling rules

In Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling we are continuing to:

- Revise the use of capital letters and full stops at the start and end of a sentence
- Focus on letter formation and handwriting
- Use the range of punctuation taught in KS1 with growing confidence including apostrophes for possession and contraction

Science

Everyday Materials

In Science, we will identify, classify and describe the everyday materials around us. Through fun activities and investigations, we will explore the properties of materials, such as wood, plastic, metal, glass and fabric, and start to explore the uses of everyday materials.



Maths

The children will cover the following objectives:

Year 1

Fractions

To recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity

To recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

Multiplication and Division

To solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher.

Year 2

Fractions

- Recognise name and write fractions of a set shape, length, object or quantity
- Write simple fractions e.g. $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6 = 3
- Find equivalent fractions e.g. $\frac{2}{4} = \frac{1}{2}$

Statistics

- Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables
- Ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quantity
- Ask and answer questions about totalling and comparing categorical data.

Time

- Tell and write the time to 5 minute intervals.

PE

The children will further develop their fundamental movement skills, focusing on ball skills and developing tactics when playing against a single opponent or by taking part in team games.

The children will also be starting athletics. They will have the chance to develop their gross motor skills and try new and exciting activities.

HISTORY

This term we are learning about Florence Nightingale. We will find out about her remarkable life as we journey through lessons about her youth, her famous voyage to Scutari, and the work she did there, as well as the work she did in her later years to improve nursing and hospital care.



RE

This half term we will be learning about the Christian Creation story and will seek to answer the following questions:

Who made the world?

Why is the word 'God' so important to Christians?



Music

The children learn songs to perform for an audience and will use their voices, body percussion and instruments as they explore pulse, rhythm and pitch and develop their improvisation skills.



Art

This term we will explore the marks that can be made by printing with a range of objects.

The children will combine these printing techniques to create a final piece, inspired by the work of the contemporary artist Karen Lederer.

Computing

This half term we will focus on creating, storing and retrieving data in the form of pictograms.
