### Everyday Materials

## PE

On Wednesdays the children will be focussing on basic dance. They will learn a variety of ways they can move around the room and will have the opportunity to choreograph their own dances.

On Fridays the children will be focussing on developing fundamental movements. The children will learn how to travel with increased control. They will develop their throwing and catching techniques.

## Geography

This term we will be learning about the United Kingdom. The children will become familiar with the map of the UK and will learn some key characteristics of the four nations.



## RE

This half term we will learn about festivals of light including Bonfire Night and Diwali. Our main focus will be: 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?'



## PSHE

We will be focusing on respectful relationships using NSPCC PANTS resources and including Anti-bullying week. We will also be thinking about our families and the people who care for us.



## Design and Technology
