## Physical development

The children will take part in a variety of Active Start and Fine Motor activities across the week.

Dance – we will be learning to move in different ways and to combine movements to create individual and small group dances.

Fundamental Movement - we will continue to explore different ways to move around a space and to control balls.

## Personal, Social and Emotional development

The children will continue to focus on managing personal hygiene and dressing.

They will learn about the importance of keeping clean and use the NSPCC PANTS resources to learn about the parts of their bodies that are private.

This half term the children will:

- Further develop their ability to share and take turns
- Continue to follow our class rules
- Focus on self-care and getting changed for PE
- Consider their emotions and those of their friends
- Learn about keeping safe online



## Mathematics

In maths lessons this term the children will have the opportunity to practise these skills in a variety of contexts.

- Representing the number 1
- Representing the number 2
- Representing the number 3
- Comparing 1, 2 and 3
- Matching numeral and picture cards
- One more and one less
- Sorting circles and triangles
- Finding shapes in the environment
- Representing 4 and 5



## Understanding the world

This half term the children will be:

- Learning about Festivals of Light including Diwali, Bonfire Night and Christmas
- Changing seasons - Autumn into Winter
- Thinking about who are the special people in their lives

## Expressive arts and design

Music and Drama - we will be taking part in the whole school Christmas Production.

Developing our craft skills including using scissors, paper and junk modelling resources.

Small World & Role Play - we will be developing collaborative play in these areas.

## Literacy

This term we are continuing with the Read, Write, Inc phonics programme.

The children will learn new letter sounds and learn to blend letters to make words. We will practise writing individual letters, our names and start to write words.

We will think about characters and plots as we share stories

The children will enjoy story and information books, joining in with singing rhymes and songs.
