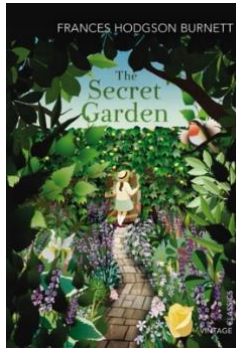


English

In Reading and Writing composition we are:

- investigating how the author develops characters
- writing in the style of the author, using description, dialogue and action to develop character
- learning to proof-read and edit our writing

In Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling we are:

- revising content from previous years in preparation for SATs
- learning to use ellipsis and apostrophes for contraction in dialogue
- revising word class
- exploring forms and tenses – simple, perfect and progressive
- Learning to spell:

Light

In this topic we are learning:

- about different light sources
- how light waves travel
- how light allows us to see objects
- about the relationship between light sources, objects and their shadows



Maths



In Maths we are learning to:

Shape

- learning to recognise angles where they meet at a point, are on a straight line, or are vertically opposite, and find missing angles
- comparing and classifying geometric shapes based on their properties and sizes
- finding unknown angles in triangles, quadrilaterals, and regular polygons
- Use a protractor to draw shapes and angles accurately

Position and Direction

- Identify and describe positions using coordinates on a full coordinate grid
- Draw, reflect and translate shapes on a grid and along axis and mirror lines

Revision

- Revising content from all topics in preparation for SATS

We are developing our knowledge, skills and ability in:

- **Striking and fielding games - cricket**
- **Athletics**



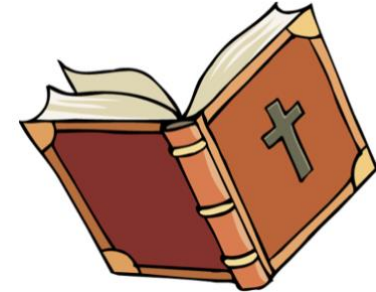
History

This term we will start with a local history study into how our school has changed over time.



RE

This term our topic is '**What would Jesus do?**' and involves learning about Jesus' teachings in the Bible and how we can relate them to our own lives and experiences.



French

Our topic this term is '**Revisiting me**'. We will learn recap talking about ourselves, numbers to 60, time phrases and daily routine conversations.



Art/ DT

In Art and Design, we will be developing our drawing skills by focussing on drawing portraits. We will learn about the artist Frida Kahlo.

In Design and Technology, we will focus on electrical systems and will be designing, making and evaluating a 'steady hand game'.

Computing

We will look at how flat file databases can be used to organise data in records. We will use tools within a database to order and answer questions about the data and use tools to solve problems.
