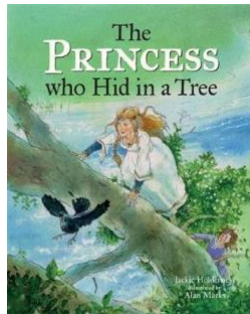


# English

### Composition we are:

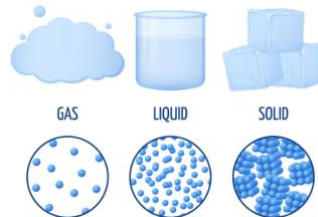

- Explore the differences in solids, liquids and gases

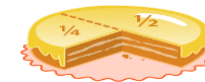
# Maths

### In Number we are:

- solving money problems involving decimal places

### In Measures we are:
