

English

We will continue to teach phonics and reading through the Read, Write, Inc programme. The children will study a range of books during these lessons. They will have the opportunity to:

- Consolidate their learning of phonemes and graphemes
- Make inferences and predictions about books
- Learn to read and spell Common Exception Words

In Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling we are continuing to:

- Revise the use of capital letters and full stops at the start and end of a sentence
- Focus on letter formation and handwriting
- Use the range of punctuation taught in KS1 with growing confidence

In Writing, we will be learning the features of a journey tale and then creating our own journey tales.

What are we learning this half term?

Science

Everyday Materials

The children will identify common materials including wood, glass, plastic and metal. They will describe the physical properties of different materials and compare the suitability of a variety of materials for particular uses.

Maths

The children will cover the following objectives:

Addition and subtraction

To revisit prior learning which used concrete and pictorial representations, and to now focus on writing number sentences to complete addition and subtraction

Fractions

To recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

To recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

Multiplication and Division

To solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher.

PE

The children will further develop their fundamental movement skills, focusing on running, throwing and tennis skills.

The children will also be starting to practise skills needed for the summer sports day, focusing on skipping with ropes and team races.

HISTORY

This term, we are learning about Florence Nightingale. We consider why she is still remembered by finding out about her life, and her work in hospitals during the Crimean War.



Art

This term, the children will discuss the work of Laren Lederer as they explore printmaking. They will select everyday objects and explore different printing effects. They will also experiment using stencils and printing using different media.



RE

This half term, we will be thinking about why the word 'God' is important to Christians. We will also explore who made the Earth.



MUSIC

This half term, our focus is tempo. Children build on their prior learning about keeping a steady pulse and explore different tempos and changes in tempo through body movement, vocals and using percussion instruments.



Computing

We will learn what 'data' is and focus on grouping data.

We will also be exploring how to ensure a healthy lifestyle when using technology.
