

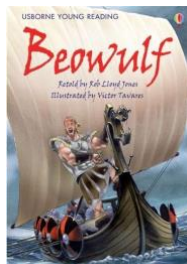
English

This half term our topic is '**What is Trinity?**'. We will look at how Christians show their beliefs about God the Trinity in worship and in the way they live.
