

English

In Phonics, the children will study a range of books. They will have the opportunity to:

- Learn new phonemes and graphemes
- Make inferences and predictions about the books

In English, the children will use the story 'The Everywhere Bear' by Julia Donaldson to inspire them to write their own stories. They will also learn about non-fiction recounts and will write their own recount of an activity in school.

Throughout the half term the children will be encouraged to:

- Expand their vocabulary
- Develop their handwriting and spelling skills
- Use full stops and capital letters correctly
- Use adjectives to create simple expanded noun phrases
- Use the past and present tense

Science

Animals including Humans

We will be learning about different animals and their classifications. We will identify animal groups based on what they eat and also based on their physical properties. We will explore how animals survive.



Maths

The children will cover the following topics this half term

Year 1

- Adding 1 more
- Counting backwards within 10
- Finding 1 less
- Using a basic number line
- Writing basic number sentences
- Learning number bonds to 20
- Subtracting using a number line
- Creating addition and subtraction fact families

Year 2

- Recognising tens and ones
- Partitioning numbers to 100
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Completing missing number problems
- Learning bonds to 10
- Learning addition and subtraction bonds within 20
- Finding bonds to 100
- Finding 10 more and 10 less
- Adding three 1 digit numbers
- Adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers

PE

We are looking forward to visiting Morton Gym every Monday this half term where the children will explore ways of travelling. They will also be able to try out some of the equipment.

In school the children will be focussing on developing basic movement skills.

History

This term we will be learning about the Great Fire of London



RE

This half term we will discuss the concept of religion, what it means to hold religious beliefs and how it is important to respect the beliefs and views of others. We will then focus on how Christians show they are thankful at Harvest.



Music

Using a Superhero theme, we will be exploring pitch. The children will also learn new songs and rhymes to support the wider curriculum.
